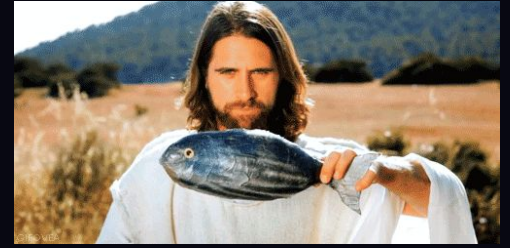
# Teacher and Son

# Jesus' Miracles

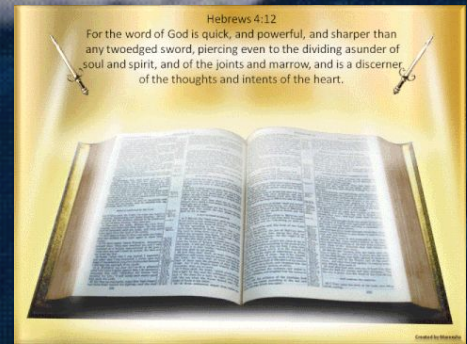
